**REPLY COMMENTS OF THE
NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF POSTMASTERS OF THE UNITED STATES
PROPOSED MAIL CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE**

The National Association of Postmasters of the United States (NAPUS) represents 40,000 Postmasters currently or formerly employed by the United States Postal Service. Its members are or were managing retail, delivery, transportation and processing operations of the federal agency. Consequently, NAPUS has a significant interest in the proposed USPS Mail Classification Schedule. NAPUS' remarks relate specifically to "Post Office Box Service."

The Postal Service indicates that "Semi-Annual Fee Groups" are based upon Post Office location. However, the Postal Service does not disclose the standards for assigning a Post Office to a particular group. NAPUS believes that the Postal Service should publish, as part of the Classification Schedule, the criteria and methodology that it employs to determine how Post Offices are assigned to Semi-Annual Fee Groups.
