**JOINT MOTION OF LIFE LINE SCREENING AND UNITED STATES POSTAL
SERVICE TO WITHDRAW MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE CONDITIONS IN
RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER NO. 39
(OCA/USPS-T1-1-2)**

(October 26, 2007)

On September 28, 2007, Life Line Screening (“Life Line”) and the United States Postal Service (“Postal Service”) filed a motion to establish protective conditions regarding the Postal Service’s response to interrogatories from the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA/USPS-T1-1). On October 9, 2007, the Commission issued Order No. 39 denying the motion but preserving the parties’ rights to renew the motion with additional information. On October 19, 2007, the Commission issued Order No. 42, granting an extension of time to respond to Order No. 39.

Although Life Line and the Postal Service initially indicated their intent to renew their motion for protective conditions, Life Line has reexamined the workpaper the sought by the OCA and determined that this workpaper can be filed publicly without placing Life Line at a prohibitive competitive disadvantage. Due to the nature of Life

Line's business, the competitors in its industry, and the purposes for which Life Line uses direct mail, Life Line believes that filing the aggregate numbers contained in the workpaper will not cause Life Line a substantial risk of competitive harm.

Accordingly, Life Line and the Postal Service move to withdraw their motion to file these responses under seal. The Postal Service will file responses to OCA/USPS-T1-1-2 today.
