NOTICE OF CHANGE IN RATES OF GENERAL APPLICABILITY
FOR A COMPETITIVE PRODUCT

(Issued January 22, 2008)

Pursuant to 39 C.F.R. § 3015.2, the Postal Service filed notice with the Commission on January 17, 2008, concerning a change in rates of general applicability for a competitive product, namely, the establishment of a premium for guaranteed delivery of Express Mail on Sunday and holidays. As required by the Commission's rules, § 3015.2(b), the filing includes an explanation and justification for the change, the effective date, and a schedule of the changed rates.¹

The establishment of a premium for guaranteed delivery of Express Mail on Sundays and holidays effects a change in the Mail Classification Schedule. Therefore, pursuant to subpart E of part 3020 of its rules, 39 C.F.R. § 3020.90 *et seq.*, the Commission provides notice of the Postal Service's Filing, affording interested persons an opportunity to express views and offer comments on whether the planned changes are inconsistent with 39 U.S.C. § 3642.

Comments are due February 19, 2008.

The premium is effective March 3, 2008.
