SIXTH NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
OF REVISIONS TO MATERIALS ACCOMPANYING ITS
FY 2007 ANNUAL COMPLIANCE REPORT -- ERRATA
(Items NP2 and NP14)
(March 17, 2008)

The Postal Service filed its FY 2007 Annual Compliance Report on December 28, 2007, along with a large number of accompanying items, including USPS-FY07-NP2, the ICRA report. On March 12, 2008, USPS-FY07-NP14 was filed to provide international mail materials in response to questions in CIR No. 1. Revisions are today being made in two items, USPS-FY07-NP2 and USPS-FY07-NP14, both in the **Non-Public annex**. For both items, the new CD-ROM provided completely replaces the original CD-ROM, as all files are included, even those which have not been revised. Since the items revised today included hard copy, replacement copies of the hard copy are also being provided to the Commission.

USPS-FY07-NP2

As explained in the Postal Service's notice regarding USPS-FY07-32, also being filed today, the need has become apparent for revisions in Cost Segment 14, Purchased Transportation. These changes result from earlier misunderstanding regarding whether certain FedEx contract accounts in the general ledger related to the Day Turn or the Night Turn. The revisions to Cost Segment 14 Transportation costs described in USPS-FY07-32 caused revisions to USPS-FY07-NP2. The revised Cost

Segment 14 costs appear in the CS14 workbook in the ICRA Core Files directory and they flow through the Domestic Tran Calcs and Reports workbooks. Additionally, the Quarters III and IV inbound EMS rates were corrected for China, Anguilla and Malaysia, and the Quarter IV inbound EMS rates were corrected for Belize on the Inbound EMS Rates CY2 tabs of the Inputs file.

USPS-FY07-NP14

As explained above, changes are being made in certain ICRA costs. These cause changes in the international mail costs reported last week in USPS-FY07-NP14, so a revised version of that is also being filed today.
