NOTICE OF AMENDED
MARKET DOMINANT PRICE ADJUSTMENT

(Issued March 27, 2008)

On March 26, 2008, the Postal Service filed an amended notice of its market dominant price adjustment, revising four prices associated with the pre-barcoded discount for Standard Mail mixed AADC letters.¹ The revisions, which were filed in response to Order No. 66 issued March 17, 2008, are 1.1 cents lower than those initially filed on February 11, 2008 and are limited to Mixed-AADC/ADC, Machinable Origin and DBMC prices. The Postal Service indicates that the changes reduce the Standard Mail increase, on average, from 2.875 percent to 2.838 percent, which, in turn, increases the unused rate change authority from 0.025 percent to 0.062 percent. It is the Commission's understanding that the planned changes are scheduled to go into effect May 12, 2008 along with the other price adjustments included in the Postal Service's February 11, 2008 notice of price adjustment.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, 39 C.F.R. § 3010.13(f), interested persons may comment on the Amended Notice. Such comments are due no later than April 7, 2007.
