NOTICE OF AMENDED CLASSIFICATION CHANGE
FOR MARKET DOMINANT PRODUCTS

(Issued March 28, 2008)

On March 20, 2008, the Postal Service filed notice concerning a change in classification that would require all Bound Printed Matter (BPM) mailings be paid by mailing permit, a requirement that currently applies only to destination entered BPM.¹ On March 27, 2008, the Postal Service filed notice of amendment to that change that would require all BPM Flats and Parcels to be paid by permit imprint only.² In addition, the Amendment would restate the requirement that destination entered BPM is subject to an annual mailing fee. The Amendment is in response to mailers' inquiries to the March 20, 2008 notice regarding the payment of certain fees related to BPM. *Id.* at 1.

Pursuant to rule 3020.92, 39 C.F.R. § 3020.92, the Commission provides notice of the Postal Service's Amendment, affording interested persons an opportunity to express views and offer comments on whether the planned changes are inconsistent with 39 U.S.C. § 3642. Comments are now due April 9, 2008.
