**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
OF FILING A GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES CONTRACT**
(May 20, 2008)

The United States Postal Service ("Postal Service") hereby gives notice, pursuant to 39 CFR § 3015.5, that the Postal Service has entered into a Global Expedited Package Services (GEPS) contract.

The contract and supporting documents establishing compliance with 39 CFR § 3015.5 are being filed separately with the Postal Regulatory Commission under seal. The names of customers who enter into respective contracts and the related contract prices are highly confidential business information. The ability of the Postal Service to negotiate additional GEPS contracts with competitive prices would be severely compromised if prices for respective agreements were disclosed publicly. Public disclosure would also compromise the ability of customers entering contracts with the Postal Service to protect their interests in negotiations with other shipping services

providers. So in accordance with industry standards, the Postal Service is giving public notice of the existence of a GEPS contract but keeping its details confidential by filing it under seal.
