**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
OF GOVERNORS' DECISION ON INBOUND PRICES UNDER EXPRESS MAIL  
INTERNATIONAL (EMS) BILATERAL/MULTILATERAL AGREEMENTS**  
(May 20, 2008)

The United States Postal Service ("Postal Service") hereby gives notice, pursuant to 39 USC § 3632(b)(3) and 39 CFR § 3015.5, that the Governors have established prices for competitive products not of general applicability for Inbound Express Mail International (EMS).

The Governors' Decision, which includes a statement of explanation and justification, and attachments thereto as well as the record of proceedings in connection with the Decision, are being filed separately with the Postal Regulatory Commission under seal. Negotiated prices under bilateral/multilateral agreements are highly confidential among postal administrations so the Postal Service is protecting them in accordance with established practice. The ability of the Postal Service to negotiate agreements with other posts would be severely compromised if prices for these types of agreements were publicly disclosed. Public disclosure could also compromise the

ability of respective foreign postal administrations to negotiate other favorable, bilateral EMS agreements in the future.
