
The Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA) hereby withdraws its Motion on *Ascertainment of Library References Requiring Sponsorship and Designation as Evidence*, November 12, 1997. OCA further withdraws interrogatories OCA/USPS-107-119, filed in two parts – on November 12 and November 14. Counsellors for the Postal Service (Eric Koetting and Susan Duchek) graciously and expeditiously considered OCA's offer to withdraw the captioned motion and interrogatories in return for an opportunity to meet with Dr. Bradley informally, to have our "how-to" questions answered in a more relaxed, face-to-face meeting at a mutually agreeable time and place. This matter has been resolved amicably. Consequently, a ruling by the Presiding Officer on OCA's November 12 motion is no longer necessary. OCA believes that this disposition of the disagreement will be satisfactory not only for us and the Postal Service, but for the Presiding Officer as well.
