In the Postal Service's response to NDMS's Motion to Compel Responses to Interrogatories NDMS/USPS-T28-27-41, filed today, it indicated that witness Smith would respond to interrogatory 41. This should be corrected to state that witness Smith will respond to part (i) of that interrogatory. Part (ii) of that interrogatory concerns rate design. No further discovery on this topic has been authorized. Accordingly, NDMS/USPS-T28-41(ii) should be included in the list of interrogatories in the Postal Service's response for which NDMS's motion to compel be denied.
