The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the responses of witness Marc Smith to the following interrogatories of NDMS, filed November 14, 1997: NDMS/USPS-T28- 38(d) and 41(l).

The responses were due to have been filed on November 21, 1997. The determination to redirect the interrogatories to witness Smith was not made until shortly before that deadline, leaving him with an insufficient amount of time within which to file timely responses. Witness Smith's preparation for and participation in the November 28, 1997, technical conference further interfered with the preparation and review of the responses.
