ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE FOR REPLY COMMENTS

(Issued July 24, 2008)

In Order No. 71, the Commission established July 29, 2008 as the deadline for filing reply comments in this proceeding.¹ On July 23, 2008, the Postal Service filed a motion requesting a three-day extension of the reply comment deadline until August 1, 2008.² In support of its request, the Postal Service indicates that the current deadline falls on the same day as the Postal Service's Board of Governors' meeting. The Postal Service believes that the brief extension will allow the Board an opportunity to consider the Postal Service's reply comments. The Postal Service does not believe that this brief extension will adversely affect any party or the Commission's deliberations in this docket.
