**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSES TO INTERROGATORIES
OF PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVE, FILED UNDER SEAL
(PR/USPS-2 AND 4)
(September 15, 2008)**

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance, one business day out of time, of its responses to PR/USPS-2 and 4. The Postal Service is today filing its responses under seal, pursuant to P.O. Ruling No. C2008-3/14, and subject to the protective conditions established in P.O. Ruling No. C2008-3/9. The responses were due on September 12, 2008, seven days from the issuance of P.O. Ruling No. C2008-3/14. However, the press of other business prevented the responses from being finalized for a timely filing on September 12. The Postal Service regrets the brief delay but does not believe that any party has been prejudiced by it. Accordingly, the Postal Service respectfully moves for late acceptance of its responses to PR/USPS-2 and 4.
