**RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO
P.O. RULING NO. C2008-3/23, PROVIDING SEVENTH STATUS REPORT
REGARDING SUPPLEMENT TO PRIVILEGE LOG
(November 7, 2008)**

The United States Postal Service hereby provides its seventh status report in response to P.O. Ruling No. C2008-3/23, regarding the supplement to the privilege log for the e-mails on Jessica Dauer Lowrance's computer. This week, the Postal Service has continued the task of reviewing the e-mail files of Ms. Lowrance and further supplementing its privilege log. Additionally, the Postal Service is nearing completion on the process of reviewing the entries highlighted by Capital One, and identifying which of the entries are also contained in the documents obtained via an electronic search based on agreed-upon Boolean search terms. The Postal Service is also working to provide additional information in the privilege log for those highlighted entries which are not contained in the set of documents obtained via an electronic search. The parties have continued informal communications throughout the week, and made progress on narrowing the scope of discovery in this docket. The Postal Service will file an

additional status report next Friday, November 14, 2008, to apprise the Commission of further developments.
