**RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO
P.O. RULING NO. C2008-3/23, PROVIDING EIGHTH STATUS REPORT
REGARDING SUPPLEMENT TO PRIVILEGE LOG
(November 14, 2008)**

The United States Postal Service hereby provides its eighth status report in response to P.O. Ruling No. C2008-3/23, regarding the supplement to the privilege log for the e-mails on Jessica Dauer Lowrance's computer. This week, the Postal Service has continued the task of reviewing the e-mail files of Ms. Lowrance and further supplementing its privilege log. Additionally, the Postal Service has provided Capital One with additional information for certain highlighted entries in the privilege log which were also contained in the set of documents obtained via an electronic search.

This process of reviewing the highlighted entries and comparing them to the documents obtained via an electronic search will continue this coming week. The parties have had multiple informal communications again this week, and continue to make progress on narrowing the scope of discovery in this docket. The Postal Service will file an additional status report next Friday, November 21, 2008, to apprise the Commission of further developments.
