**RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO  
P.O. RULING NO. C2008-3/23, PROVIDING EIGHTEENTH STATUS REPORT  
REGARDING SUPPLEMENT TO PRIVILEGE LOG  
(January 30, 2009)**

The United States Postal Service hereby provides its eighteenth status report in response to P.O. Ruling No. C2008-3/23, regarding the supplement to the privilege log for the e-mails on Jessica Dauer Lowrance's computer. This week, the Postal Service has continued the task of reviewing the documents obtained via an electronic Boolean search, and supplementing its privilege log. The Postal Service expects to make additional progress on this task in the coming weeks, and hopes to be able to provide an estimated completion date for the initial review of the documents obtained in this initial search. Also this week, the Postal Service has consolidated entries from several different directories from Ms. Lowrance's computer into one log, and will begin the process of reviewing and finalizing that spreadsheet. That log alone exceeds five-thousand entries, including replies and forwards of individual messages.

The Postal Service will file an additional status report next Friday, February 6, 2009, to apprise the Commission of further developments.
