PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVES MOTION FOR ACCEPTANCE
OF ANSWER TO POSTAL SERVICE RESPONSE

(February 25, 2009)

The Postal Service filed a response to a portion of the Public Representatives' Reply Comments having to do with the broad issue of confidentiality and its effects in this proceeding and future proceedings. See Response of the United States Postal Service to the Reply Comments of the Public Representatives, February 19, 2009 (Response). In its Response, the Postal Service asserted that the Public Representatives had made arguments that were "utterly fatuous." In the accompanying Motion of the United States Postal Service for Leave to Respond to the Reply Comments of the Public Representatives, the Postal Service refers to "misimpressions, if not outright factual misstatements, regarding the Postal Service's treatment of sensitive nonpublic information." In order to help repair the damage to public discourse that the Public Representatives have apparently done, it asks that the Commission accept this brief Answer to the Postal Service's Reply.
