The Statement of Explanation and Justification accompanying the Governors Decision (No. 09-01) states an overall (average) price increase for the following competitive products and services: Parcel Select, additional 0.5 percent; Premium Forwarding Service, 20.2 percent; International Priority Airmail, 20.8 percent; International Surface Airlift, 2.4 percent; and International Ancillary Service, 6.1 percent. Please provide the weights used to derive the Before and After Rates indices relied upon to calculate the overall (average) percentage price increase for each product and service referenced above.¹ Please show all calculations.
