**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF
CLASSIFICATION CHANGE**

(April 3, 2009)

Pursuant to 39 C.F.R. §§ 3020.90 and 3020.91, the United States Postal Service hereby gives notice of changes in classification governing Global Express Guaranteed (GXG) service. The first change deletes the minimum dimensional requirements for GXG in Mail Classification Schedule (MCS) section 2205.2, which would thereby allow pieces that are less than the current dimensions to be accepted as long as the shipping label fits on the face of the mail piece. The second change assigns Libya to country group 4, as FedEx has advised that it will now offer service to this destination country.

The Postal Service hereby submits to the Commission conforming changes in the Mail Classification Schedule. The Postal Service believes that the changes are consistent with 39 U.S.C. § 3642 and should be incorporated by the Commission into the MCS. These changes are to become effective no sooner than fifteen days after the date of this filing.
