NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF AMENDMENT TO ITS
REQUEST TO ADD POSTAL PRODUCTS TO THE MAIL CLASSIFICATION
SCHEDULE IN RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 154
(May 8, 2009)

The United States Postal Service hereby provides notice of an amendment to its March 10, 2009 Request to add Address Management Services to the Mail Classification Schedule as a market dominant product. The changes reflect recent developments in how the Postal Service wishes to offer the *FASTforward*[®] Move Update Notification (FFMUN) component of Address Management Services.

FASTforward[®] service is one of the methods that mailers use to comply with Move Update requirements. Currently, the Postal Service charges separately for the core *FASTforward*[®] service, which enables mailers to apply change of address information to mailpieces prior to mailing, and a separate service, *FFMUN*, which sends the change of address information in a format that can be used to update the customer's database. Effective June 1, 2009, the Postal Service will no longer offer *FFMUN* as a stand-alone component of Address Management Services. Instead

FFMUN service will be included in the existing *FASTforward* MLOCR service. The current \$5000 annual fees for *FASTforward* MLOCR will not change.

The Postal Service provided *FASTforward* licensees with notice of this change by conducting a webinar with all *FASTforward* licensees, posting the notice on the *FASTforward* page on the Postal Service's RIBBS website at usps.com, and discussing this change at The National Association of Presort Mailers (NAPM) conference.

Attachment A shows the appropriate changes to pages 4 and 8 in the proposed MCS language for Address Management Services that was filed on March 10, 2009.

DSF²® Service (Delivery Sequence File – 2nd Generation)

The DSF² service is used to check mailing address accuracy, identify address types, and obtain walk sequence numbers. The DSF² database is the most complete Postal Service address database available, containing every deliverable mailing address in the United States, and is used to: verify that address lists are correct and complete, identify business versus residential addresses, recognize commercial mail receiving agencies (CMRA), provide walk sequence numbers and postal codes, identify seasonal addresses, detect addresses vacant for over 90 days, and categorize addresses by delivery type, e.g., curbside, door slot, box, etc. DSF² processing includes address standardization that may be used to apply for CASS qualification.

eLOT[®] Service (enhanced Line of Travel)

eLOT service gives mailers the ability to sort their mailings in approximate carrier-casing sequence. Copying is allowed for an additional fee.

FASTforward[®] MLOCR

The FASTforward system makes change-of-address information for moves available to mailers so that it can be applied to a mail piece while it is being processed on a Multi-line Optical Character Reader (MLOCR). Customers use FASTforward Move Update Notification (FFMUN) electronic files to update their databases with change of address information.

~~The FASTforward Move Update Notification (FFMUN) service enables the FASTforward[®] change-of-address information to be sent to the customer in an electronic file. The electronic file can then be used to update the customer's database.~~

Five-Digit ZIP

The Five-Digit ZIP service provides detailed street data for multi-coded cities (i.e., cities that have more than one 5-digit ZIP Code), so that the proper ZIP Code can be identified. Copying is allowed for an additional fee.
