POSTAL SERVICE'S LEGAL AUTHORITY TO SET FEES

On May 29, 2009, the Postal Service filed a response to Chairman's Information Request No. 1. As part of its response to Question 2(c), the Postal Service set out its legal theory as to how it can set fees for certain "postal services" without Commission oversight.
