PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING GRANTING MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued June 11, 2009)

On June 9, 2009, Pitney Bowes Inc. (Pitney Bowes) filed a motion for an extension of time until June 24, 2009 to file its response to Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2.¹ The Motion indicates that more time is needed to prepare responses from several internal business units and to try to resolve certain differences with the Postal Service. Pitney Bowes also notes that the hearing previously scheduled for June 16, 2009 has been cancelled; therefore, the requested relief will not unduly delay these proceedings. The Postal Service supports the Motion.

The delay does not appear unreasonable under the circumstances, and there appears to be no prejudice to any participant from granting the request.

RULING

Pitney Bowes Inc. Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2, filed June 9, 2009, is granted.
