MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR MODIFICATION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
RELATING TO SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY
(June 11, 2009)

On June 9, 2009, Pitney Bowes moved for a two-week extension of time in which to file responses to Presiding Officer's Information Request (POIR) No. 2, a motion granted in Presiding Officer's Ruling (POR) No. 8. The Postal Service hereby requests comparable two-week extensions of the dates recently established by POR No. 7 relating to notification and filing of surrebuttal testimony. Specifically, the Postal Service proposes that parties have until June 26 to submit notices of intent to file surrebuttal testimony (rather than June 12), and until July 6 to file such testimony (rather than June 22). An extension is warranted because the answers provided by Pitney Bowes to POIR No. 2 will affect both the decision of the Postal Service whether to file surrebuttal testimony, and the contents of any such testimony. Pitney Bowes counsel has authorized the Postal Service to represent that Pitney Bowes supports this motion.
