I just can't imagine without having a post office. Occasionally I like to send a package and I'd have to go approximately 20 miles to send it out now. And since I can't see and can't drive anymore, I have to hire someone to take me to the post office. So, please put back our post office.

My new mailbox is over a mile from my home and I have to have a neighbor get my mail for me. I get medicine in my mailbox now, but I liked it better when it came to my locked box at the post office. Sometimes people take things from a mailbox which isn't locked. Thank you.
