On August 17, 2009, the United States Postal Service filed objections to the interrogatories listed above. On August 31, 2009, the American Postal Workers Union filed a motion to compel those responses to those interrogatories. The Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is withdrawing its objections and providing responses to all subparts of interrogatories APWU/USPS-T2-10 through T2-12 today. The Postal Service is of the view that, upon review of the responses filed today, APWU will concur that the disagreement between the parties sought to be resolved by its motion is now moot.
