PRESIDING OFFICER'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2

In response to Commission Information Request No. 1 (CIR No. 1), Question 16, the Postal Service provided a table which purports to be "a list of 21 stations and branches that have been closed during the Fiscal Years 2005 through 2008."<sup>1</sup> Concurrently, the Postal Service filed an errata to witness Matalik's testimony which, among other things, revises "Table 1: Station and Branch Closures FY2005 – 2008."<sup>2</sup> Table 1 indicates that a total of 28 stations and branches were closed during FY 2005 through FY 2008. *Id.* at 7. Please reconcile these figures and provide any necessary additional corrections. The response is due no later than September 21, 2009.
