RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
TO PRESIDING OFFICER'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2
(September 16, 2009)

On September 14, 2009, the Commission issued Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2 (POIR No. 2). POIR No. 2 notes that in response to Commission Information Request No. 1 (CIR No. 1), Question 16, the Postal Service provided a table showing a list of "21 stations and branches that have been closed during the Fiscal Years 2005 through 2008."¹ Concurrently, the Postal Service filed an errata to witness Matalik's testimony which revised "Table 1: Station and Branch Closures FY2005 – 2008"² to indicate that a total of 28 stations and branches were closed during FY 2005 through FY 2008.³ POIR No. 2 requests the Postal Service to reconcile these figures and provide any necessary additional corrections.

The Postal Service is filing new errata to witness Matalik's testimony in order to reconcile the figures.
