MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO COMPEL
A RESPONSE TO INTERROGATORY DBP/USPS-31
(September 17, 2009)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing of its opposition to the August 10, 2009 motion to compel a response to the above referenced interrogatory. The delay was due to an administrative oversight.

The scope of the discovery dispute is narrow. The Postal Service requests that its oversight not deter the Commission from deciding the underlying dispute without first considering its explanation of why the motion is premised upon a misreading of the record. The Postal Service believes that no party would be prejudiced by the Commission hearing from both sides of the dispute in this matter even at this late date. Accordingly, the Postal Service moves for consideration of its opposition pleading.
