**RESPONSE**

For each Fiscal Year, the Postal Service will file a Library Reference containing copies of available discontinuance decision records pertaining to the stations and branches referenced in Table 1 of USPS-T-2 that were discontinued that year.

FY 2005 -- USPS Library Reference N2009-1/14

FY 2006 -- USPS Library Reference N2009-1/15

FY 2007 -- USPS Library Reference N2009-1/16

FY2008 -- USPS Library Reference N2009-1/17

The Library References will contain copies of each discontinuance decision accompanied by the documentation presented to Headquarters for review in support of the discontinuance proposal, except as noted below. The searches of FY 2005 and 2006 records at Headquarters and in the respective Area and District offices have yielded incomplete results.

FY 2005: No records pertaining to the discontinuance of the Watsessing Station, Bloomfield NJ have been located.

FY 2006: Final agency decisions have been located, but not the documentation presented to Headquarters in support of the proposals for Statehouse Station, Topeka, KS; Universal City Station, North Hollywood, CA; and Apparel Mart Station, Brookhollow, TX.
