On September 17, 2009, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 300, establishing this docket for the purpose of reviewing the Postal Service's request to add an agreement to the GEPS 2 product group.¹ In Order No. 300, the Commission directed the Postal Service to file the executed version of a modification to the relevant contract by September 21, 2009.² Attached to this notice is the redacted version of the modification. **MODIFICATION ONE TO THE
GLOBAL CUSTOMIZED MAIL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE AND**

This Modification amends the Global Customized Mail Agreement between [REDACTED] ("Mailer") with offices at [REDACTED], and the United States Postal Service ("USPS"), an independent establishment of the Executive Branch of the United States Government, with offices at 475 L'Enfant Plaza SW, Washington, DC 20260-9998, signed by the Mailer on August 20, 2009, and by the USPS on August 20, 2009, pursuant to Article 14 of that Agreement. The Mailer and the USPS may be referred to individually as a "Party" and together as the "Parties."

The Parties may execute this Modification in one or more counterparts (including by facsimile or by electronic means such as .pdf format). Not all Parties need be signatories to the same document. All counterpart signed documents shall be deemed an original and one instrument.

Article 7. OBLIGATIONS OF THE MAILER, paragraph 6 shall now read as follows:

6. Tender. To present the mailings at a Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU) approved by the USPS to receive Qualifying Mail.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in force.
