**APPLICATION OF GAMEFLY, INC.,
FOR NON-PUBLIC TREATMENT OF
MOTION FOR SHOW-CAUSE ORDER
AND ACCOMPANYING DOCUMENTS
(September 25, 2009)**

Pursuant to Rule 3007.22, 39 C.F.R. § 3007.22, GameFly, Inc. ("GameFly") applies for nonpublic treatment of (1) the material marked as protected on pages 7-12 of the "Motion Of GameFly, Inc., For Order Directing Interested Parties To Show Cause Why Certain Documents And Information Designated As Proprietary By The Postal Service Should Not Be Unsealed" filed by GameFly today, and (2) the documents attached to the motion. GameFly is filing a redacted version of the motion electronically on the Commission's website.

The documents that GameFly is filing under seal were marked as confidential when produced by the Postal Service in discovery to GameFly. The motion requests, pursuant to Rule 3007.31, that the Commission issue an order directing the Postal Service and interested third parties to show cause when the protection for the documents should not be removed. Until the Commission determines whether to unseal the documents and information, Rule 3007.31(a) requires that they remain under seal.
