MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INITIAL COMMENTS
(October 19, 2009)

Commission Order No. 292 (Sept. 2, 2009) initiated this docket and, as published in the Federal Register, established Oct. 26, 2009, as the due date for initial comments. 74 Fed.Reg. 49190 (Sept. 25, 2009). The Postal Service hereby moves for a one-week extension of this date, until November 2, 2009. The reasons for this request relate to the complexities of coordinating a comprehensive response, in light of the Postal Service's National Executive Conference later this week, as well as other pressing regulatory issues that require immediate management attention. These matters would interfere with presentation of a well-developed response to the Commission proposed

rules. The requested one-week extension would result in a more considered response.
