**MOTION OF GAMEFLY, INC.,
TO UNSEAL UNREDACTED VERSION OF
EIGHTH DISCOVERY REQUESTS (GFL/USPS-212-213)
(October 19, 2009)**

Pursuant to Rule 3007.31 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, GameFly, Inc. ("GameFly") respectfully moves to unseal the unredacted version of GameFly's Eighth Discovery Requests (GFL/USPS-212-213), which GameFly filed under seal today.

The discovery requests concern estimates of the Postal Service's costs of handling DVD mailers. The Postal Service produced the estimates and related documentation in response to previous GameFly discovery requests, but designated the material as proprietary under the protective conditions in the case.

GameFly believes that the material should be unsealed pursuant to 39 C.F.R. § 3007.31 for the reasons set forth in GameFly's September 25 "Motion For Order Directing Interested Parties To Show Cause Why Certain Documents And Information Designated As Proprietary By The Postal Service Should Not Be Unsealed." We incorporate the September 25 Motion by reference here.
