APPLICATION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
CONCERNING NONPUBLIC STATUS OF ITS

The Postal Service has today filed responses to several discovery responses of GameFly, Inc. under seal: GFL/USPS-196 and 198. The first discovery response provides further clarification of an internal Postal Service PowerPoint presentation regarding the disc mail industry, and specific disc mail customers. The second discovery response provides detailed information concerning aspects of a cost study that examined customer-specific DVD processing costs. The Postal Service considers such information to be confidential, for the reasons discussed in the pleading it filed on October 19, 2009. The Postal Service hereby incorporates that document by reference.
