ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued October 21, 2009)

The Postal Service requests an extension of time to file initial comments in this proceeding from October 26, 2009 to November 2, 2009.<sup>1</sup> The Postal Service cites its upcoming National Executive Conference and other pressing regulatory issues needing immediate management attention as reasons for the extension. *Id.* at 1. The Postal Service adds that these matters would interfere with the presentation of a well developed response to the proposed rules. *Id.* at 1-2.

The Commission finds the request reasonable. An extension will not prejudice any party. The Postal Service's motion for an extension of time is granted. The due dates for comments in this proceeding are revised as follows: initial comments are due November 2, 2009, and reply comments are due December 1, 2009.
