APPLICATION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
CONCERNING NONPUBLIC STATUS OF ITS
RESPONSES TO DISCOVERY REQUESTS OF GAMEFLY, INC.
(GFL/USPS-109, 145, 151, AND 161)
(October 27, 2009)

The Postal Service has today filed responses to several discovery responses of GameFly, Inc. under seal: GFL/USPS-109, 145, 151, and 161. First, GFL/USPS-109 requests further information regarding the contents of an internal PowerPoint presentation discussing the methods by which an individual disc mail customer was allowed to pay postage, while GFL/USPS-151 requests further clarification of the opinion of a single postal employee concerning that topic. Second, GFL/USPS-145 and 161 request further information regarding the reasons behind the Postal Service's internal determination not to file a price and classification proposal for two-way disc mailers with the Commission.

The Postal Service considers all of this internal deliberative information inherently confidential, for the reasons discussed in the pleading it filed on October 19, 2009. See Opposition of the United States Postal Service to the Motion of GameFly, Inc. to Unseal Certain Documents Produced in Discovery. The Postal Service hereby incorporates that document by reference.
