MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF ITS RESPONSES TO  
GLF/USPS-98, 101, 118, 121, 130, 138, 140, 154, 187, 197, 202, 210  
(October 30, 2009)

The Postal Service hereby moves for the late acceptance of its responses to the following discovery requests of GameFly, Inc.: GFL/USPS-98, 101, 118, 121, 130, 138, 140, 154, 187, 197, 202, and 210. These responses to GFL/USPS-98, 101, 118, 121, 130, 138, 140, and 154 were due on due on October 2, 2009, the responses to GFL/USPS-187 and 197 were due on October 20, 2009, and the responses to GFL/USPS-202 and 210 were due on October 22, 2009. The Postal Service was unable to provide responses to these institutional discovery requests within the 14-day timeframe established by the Commission's rules for a number of reasons. These discovery requests required extensive cross-functional consultation, both at Headquarters and with field officials, in order to provide full, accurate responses. This effort was further complicated by the need to also work on the large number of other discovery requests that have also been submitted by GameFly. The consultation with respect to GFL/USPS-101, 130, 138 was further complicated by the fact that the responses required investigation into events that occurred a number of years ago. Finally, the Postal Service's ability to respond timely was further delayed by

the press of other business in this and other proceedings. The Postal Service regrets the delay, and wishes to assure the Commission, and all interested parties, that it is attempting to adhere to applicable discovery deadlines as diligently as possible, given current resources.
