**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF
CLASSIFICATION CHANGES**

November 4, 2009

Pursuant to 39 C.F.R. §§ 3020.90 and 3020.91, the United States Postal Service (Postal Service) hereby gives notice of two minor changes in classification for market dominant products. These two changes conform to the classification changes presented in Docket No. CP2010-8, which gives notice of the rate and classification changes for competitive products as provided in the Decision of the Governors of the United States Postal Service on Changes in Rates and Classes of General Applicability for Competitive Products (Governors' Decision No. 09-13). Each is described briefly below.

The first minor change in classification concerns the maximum dimensional requirements for Inbound Surface Parcel Post at Universal Postal Union (UPU) rates. The classification language for this product would be modified to delete specific maximum size dimensions for circular parcels. This is consistent with identical classification changes presented in Docket No. CP2010-8 for Outbound Priority Mail International service, Inbound Air Parcel Post, Global Expedited Package Services

(GEPS) Contracts, and Global Plus Contracts. Consequently, one uniform set of maximum dimensions would apply to international parcel post services.

The second minor change in classification concerns the market dominant country group assignment for Kosovo. As explained in Governors' Decision No. 09-13, country group assignments would be established for Kosovo in accordance with the existing country group assignments for Serbia. Consequently, for market dominant First-Class Mail International service, Kosovo would be assigned to country group 5 for First-Class Mail International service.

The Postal Service hereby submits that the attached conforming changes to the Mail Classification Schedule are consistent with 39 U.S.C. § 3642 and should be incorporated by the Commission into the Mail Classification Schedule. Consistent with the parallel classification changes for competitive products noticed in Docket No. CP2010-8, the classification changes set forth herein are to become effective at 12:01 a.m. on January 4, 2010.
