

AUSPL witness Mario Principe does hereby amend and supplement his cross examination testimony given on November 18, 2009, with respect to his previous response to the following interrogatory of the United States Postal Service: Interrogatory USPS/AUSPL-T1-1b which in part asked: "Please explain the basis for and provide documentation supporting the estimate..... of the space utilized by the Postal Service to house these various operations."

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This concerns the request of the Postal Service to provide the name of the person(s) who provided the data on the number of square feet used to determine the percentage of leased space owned by AUSPL members

Approximately three years ago, AUSPL President Gary L. Poelstra inquired as to the amount of square feet leased by the Postal Service and the amount of square feet the Postal Service owned.

He asked (then) USPS Manager of Real Estate, Art Strange, who provided the figure of 97 million square feet of leased space and 172 million square feet of space owned by the Postal Service. In three years time, we assumed the amount of space would be less, not more, due to the ongoing closing and consolidation of postal buildings; therefore, increasing our percentage.

Mr. Poelstra does not recall the name of the Postal Service representative who indicated to him that the Postal Service leases 105,012,925 square feet of space. This revised figure further reduced the percentage of leased space owned by AUSPL members.

Mr. Poelstra spoke with Candace Kinne, Leasing Team Leader, Western Facilities Service Office, Englewood, CO on November 19, 2009 who indicated that excluding GSA leases, there are 91,010,223 square feet of regular leased net interior space. This information was taken from Blue Page Facilities Management System Building Inventory. This figure would increase the percentage of leased space owned by AUSPL Members.
