CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2

(Issued November 25, 2009)

Pursuant to 39 CFR § 3015.6, the Postal Service is requested to provide a written response to the following questions which follow up the Postal Service's response of November 19, 2009.<sup>1</sup> To assist in the completion of the record, responses are due as soon as practicable, but no later than December 1, 2009.

The Postal Service's response filed November 19, 2009, includes an entry for "All Other Competitive International (including Services)," which includes Inbound International Expedited Services, Inbound Air Parcel Post, International Priority Airlift (IPA), International Surface Airlift (ISAL), International Direct Sacks M-Bags, Inbound Surface Parcel Post (at non-UPU rates), International Money Transfer Service, International Ancillary Services, and competitive negotiated service agreements.<sup>2</sup> With respect to the foregoing:

1. Please provide attributable cost, revenue, and volume data for each product grouped in "All Other Competitive International (including Services)" at the same level of detail provided for all other competitive products in this docket.
