**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE NOTICE OF EXPIRATION OF NEGOTIATED
SERVICES AGREEMENT**
(November 27, 2009)

In PRC Order No. 309, the Commission granted the Postal Service's Motion for Temporary Relief to extend the contract approved in this docket to November 30, 2009.¹ In the additional time afforded it for further review and analysis, the Postal Service determined that it would not renew the GEPS agreement with this customer. Therefore, the Postal Service now provides notice that the contract that is the subject of this docket will terminate on November 30, 2009.

Conclusion

For the reasons discussed, the Postal Service asks the Commission to remove the negotiated services agreement that is the subject of this docket from the competitive products list.
