**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE
OF RESPONSES TO CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2**

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of filing its responses to Chairman's Information Request No. 2, which was issued on November 25, 2009. According to the Chairman's Information Request, responsive information was to be filed no later than December 1, 2009. The response was delayed because of the need for extra time to assemble all the appropriate files to fully respond to the Commission's inquiry, and for final review prior to filing, particularly in light of various personnel's pre-scheduled leave plans during the intervening Thanksgiving holiday.
