PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING  
GRANTING MOTIONS FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE

(Issued December 7, 2009)

For proper case management, this ruling grants nine motions for late acceptance that were unopposed, but have not previously been resolved by a ruling.
