**MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR  
LATE ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSE TO  
CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 1, QUESTION 1(A)**  
(December 9, 2009)

The Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its response to Chairman's Information Request (CHIR) No. 1, Question 1(a). This CHIR was filed on November 2, 2009, and responses were due on November 9, 2009.

The delay in responding has been caused by a number of factors. The response to Question 1(a) required internal consultations with a number of postal personnel, to determine the appropriate method in which to prepare the requested analysis. These consultations were affected by the related tasks being performed for the upcoming Annual Compliance Report (ACR). Furthermore, the tasks of gathering the data, completing the analysis, and finalizing the response were further delayed by the press of other business, including work related to the ACR. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but does not believe that any party has been materially prejudiced by it.
