In accordance with 39 C.F.R. § 3007.21 and Presiding Officer's Ruling No. N2009-1/8 (September 25, 2009), the Postal Service has redacted the facility-specific finance numbers from the public version of this Library Reference. A non-public version

of the Library Reference containing those finance numbers also is being filed.
