AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION, AFL-CIO NOTICE OF INTENTION
TO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC FORUM

Pursuant to the Commission's Notice of Public Forum and Opportunity to Comment (January 20, 2010), the American Postal Workers Union hereby gives notice of its intention to be present and participate as appropriate in the February 10, 2010, Public Forum. The APWU appreciates the opportunity to participate in this public forum and thanks the Commission for convening this public forum.

It is expected that the undersigned legal counsel, Darryl J. Anderson, will be present for APWU at the Forum. The APWU wishes to comment on the Postal Service's plans for financial stability, to address the reasons for the Postal Service's present financial difficulties, and to suggest actions and policies that would provide relief from those difficulties. The APWU has filed an initial statement in writing in this proceeding. Insofar as it would be useful to the Commission, the APWU will be prepared to discuss that statement orally at this forum. In addition, the APWU wishes to emphasize the need for a determination of non-compliance by the Commission under Section 3653(b)(1) finding that the Postal Service's rates for First Class letter mail violate Section 3622(e) of the Act.
