MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF  
FIRST RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
TO ORDER NO. 391, AMENDING REQUESTED MCS LANGUAGE  
FOR ADDRESS MANAGEMENT SERVICES  
(February 23, 2010)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its first response to Postal Regulatory Commission Order No. 391 (January 13, 2010). As part of that Order, the Commission direct that eight additional services<sup>1</sup> be added to the Market Dominant Product List as elements of Address Management Services. The Commission then ordered that the Postal Service shall within 30 days of the Order provide draft descriptions of these services. That deadline fell on February 12, 2010. Winter storms that closed the Federal Government on February 8 to 11, and Postal Service Headquarters on February 10 to 11, delayed the review process for the Postal Service's response. The Postal Service needed additional time to make the draft language accurate and complete. The response is being filed today, as soon as it was ready for filing.
