Re: Executive Summary to the Appeal of the Suspension of Crescent Lake
Oregon Post Office Docket PI -2010-1.

Dear Postal Regulatory Commission,

This is the last opportunity for our resort town and community to comment on Docket PI -2010-1; The Suspension of the Crescent Lake, Oregon Post Office. Attached to this letter are two signed petitions. I believe the United States Post Service (USPS) Representatives received a copy of the first petition (Attachment A) at the March 14, 2006 town hall meeting.

The second petition (Attachment B) was signed Spring 2009. This petition was used as a **measure of the town's sentiment regarding the suspension of the Crescent Lake Post Office**. As you will see by both petitions sentiments have not changed over the years. The signers of the petition are all full-time and part-time residents to our resort community. All signers rely on the USPS to provide reasonable services.

Also, attached is the latest correspondence (Attachment C) between Congressman Walden and Kim Anderson; District Manager, February 22, 2010. In this correspondence Kim Anderson does not mention to Congressman Walden that the Crescent Lake Post Office has been officially closed. He only **mentions that the situation is "still in flux."** This letter is dated after Kim Anderson, District Manager had requested a meeting on February 17, 2010 with Chief Tim Cramblit, Central Cascades Fire & EMS, and Kim Anderson's personally selected representatives. At this meeting the USPS Representatives gave Chief Cramblit a copy of the "Final Determination to close the Suspended Crescent Lake Oregon Post Office." This document was allegedly posted January 2009. At the meeting the USPS Representatives were unsure as to the location of the postings. Then settled on a community miles away.

So naturally the community once again turned to the PRC for help. In the document to close the Crescent Lake Post Office it states that **we in the community are able to have "residential delivery of oversized packages and accountable mail if we reside within one half mile of the courier's route."** However, the Crescent, Oregon Post Mistress states this will not happen. Apparently, the Crescent Post Mistress did not have an opportunity to read the Final Determination document that she allegedly posted. Yet the document bears the stamp of the Crescent Post Office.

Also attached is a document (Attachment D) from Kim Anderson, District Manager, to Chief Cramblit stating that **we had been offered "Curbside Service". This was the first we had heard of this offer.** So some in the town and surrounding community were very pleased with this development. However, the result of asking for "Curbside Service" was at first flatly turned down by the Crescent Post Mistress. Now the USPS Representative, Scott Foster, Manager Postal Operations, is offering "street side service." After researching on the USPS website I found documentation for "Curbside Service" and "Combined Delivery Points" but not "Street Side Service." Does this once again mean the offers given by the USPS are not valid?

The current courier route is from Chemult, Oregon, a town located over 27 miles away from Crescent Lake, Oregon and over 18 miles south of Crescent, Oregon. The route traveled by the courier passes several district that represent Crescent Lake, Oregon area. They are considered Crescent Lake, Oregon by the Klamath County Tax Assessor's Office. They are residents that currently have Crescent Lake Post Office boxes and are entitled to the offer of "Curbside Service" and "residential deliver of oversized packages and accountable mail" because they all reside "within one half mile of the courier's route." By informing residents that they are entitled to these services USPS has opened opportunities and once the community signs up for the available services the expected cost savings quoted in the allegedly posted Final Determination Document would be erroneous. In fact, I am pretty sure once the offered services are fully implemented a more economical approach would be to come back to give us a zip code of our own, and some sort of part time post office in Crescent Lake.

Once again, if there had been transparency and open discussions regarding our post office we could

have helped the USPS in the decision. The USPS would most likely have been pleased with the results. Instead the USPS was determined to dictate terms to us without fully understanding the total ramifications.

In the past the USPS has offered placing clusters of privately owned mailboxes along state Highway 58. The result of boxes clustered along a major trucking route along with the additional fact that our average annual snow levels are over 180 inches per winter, would result in the mail not being delivered, mail not protected, and the mail boxes becoming dangerous to access. Clusters of unattended mailboxes were discounted during the March 14, 2006 town hall by the USPS Representatives when they actually came up to Crescent Lake, Oregon and saw first hand the unique environment of our mountain town and community.

As we approach the end of the comment period for communities across America. I would respectfully request the opportunity to contact, Richard Oliver or Annie Kennedy regarding any pertinent changes in the provisions offered by the USPS.

What the outcome of the Commission's Hearings on Docket PI -2010-1 will be for the resort town of Crescent Lake, Oregon we do not know. At times we have lost hope in trying to communicate and work with the USPS. The USPS seems eager enough to take our money, require us to use the USPS for everyday mail service, but will not communicate with us in an open and transparent manner.

Clearly, there has been no transparency in this process. Instead the process appears to be dictatorial, deceptive, and secretive. The community was dumb struck to learn there had been an alleged posting of the intent to close the Crescent Lake, Oregon Post Office and an alleged posting of the Final Determination to close the Crescent Lake, Oregon Post Office. Both, if they actually took place, did so without any word or communication to our town and community. Both were allegedly posted in a community over 17 miles away. Then once this alleged posting took place no one was informed it had occurred. As of December 2009, when a member of our community received a letter from Annie Kennedy, of the PRC, our post office was still listed as suspended. It was only after we had filed an appeal regarding Docket PI -2010-1 on January 15, 2010 and Keith Chu, a reporter for The Bulletin, the Bend, Oregon newspaper, wrote an article regarding our appeal, that our zip code was eliminated from the USPS website. So on February 15, 2010 our zip code was active and on February 17, 2010 it was totally removed from the USPS website. This has been beyond belief!

As a mountain resort town and surrounding community we have a very unique distinctive lifestyle. **losing our historic town's identity puts our community at risk. Just blending our town with a neighboring town with a similar name has already delayed emergency response.** This has which can cost victims vital minutes and hours. I understand that the USPS representatives do not consider this a reasonable issue. However, they have not been the ones waiting for help to arrive. They have not been the ones **waiting for search and rescue to come. They have not been the ones waiting for "out of area emergency responders" to help in fighting wildland fires. The USPS scoffing at our needs and scoffing at**

our request is not a transparent constructive process.

Losing our identity affects the economics of our resort community. Visitors that rely on mapping programs to guide them to our businesses are sent miles in the wrong direction. I realize that the USPS representatives feel that this is not their affair since mapping programs really should not rely on USPS zip codes for directions. Over the past four years the business owners have had to listen to and work to resolve the conflicts that the loss of our unique zip code has caused. It has not been the USPS clarifying the problems. The USPS are not the ones waiting up into late into the night for a client, with room reservations, to finally arrive. The USPS has not been out in front of the problems, they have produced by combining Crescent and Crescent Lake, Oregon. The USPS has not helped to alleviate the distress and problems they have created.

We have tried to make it very clear, we are not Crescent, Oregon. We are Crescent Lake, Oregon. Crescent resides on a completely different state highway, Highway 97. Where Crescent Lake resides along the state Highway 58. Highway 97 runs north/south, Highway 58 runs east/west. Two completely different highways and two completely different directions. (Attachment E: Maps of area)

I do want to thank the Commission for reading all of our concerns and for reviewing how we and other communities across the country are being treated. The community is hopeful that through this process we will see openness and transparency. We want to be partners in the decision regarding **Crescent Lake, Oregon's Post Office. We know our community and we know and understand the unique factors** that affect our daily lives as we live high in the Cascades Mountains.




Thank you for your email of January 8, 2010, to the Postal Regulatory Commission regarding the status of the post office in Crescent Lake, Oregon and the change in ZIP Code. I have been requested to respond to you on their behalf.

On March 30, 2007, a letter was sent to all postal customers in the Crescent Lake community advising them of the option to receive curbside delivery or continue to have Post Office Box services. At that time, we notified them that the ZIP Code would change to 97733 for those individuals choosing street delivery.

On March 7, 2008, we once again contacted all customers in the area regarding the suspension of service at the Crescent Lake post office and requested their opinion concerning the service they were currently receiving and what effect officially discontinuing the post office would have on the community. At the same time we also advised customers if a permanent change was implemented customers could continue to use the name of Crescent Lake in their mailing address, but the ZIP Code would change to 97733.

At this time, we provide retail services at the Odell Sportsman Store for about one hour a day. Customers can also access retail services, change of address services, redeliveries, free parcel pick-ups and many other postal products and services through the USPS website www.usps.com or by calling 1-800-ASK-USPS (1-800-275-8777) Monday - Friday - 8:00 am - 8:30 pm Eastern Time, Saturday - 8:00 am-6:00 pm Eastern Time. We try to make it as convenient as possible for customers to use our services even though we no longer have a full service post office in Crescent Lake.

I appreciate you allowing us to explain our position in this matter, understanding this is not the outcome you had hoped for and regret any inconvenience you have experienced. We look forward to providing you exceptional service for years to come.
