This material consists of information regarding the post offices whose operations have been suspended by the Postal Service because of expiration or termination of a lease covering the post office facilities. This material was provided voluntarily to the Public Representatives by the Postal Service pursuant to the Commission's direction in Order No. 335 that the Public Representatives work with the Postal Service to develop an accurate representation of how written procedures for emergency suspensions operate in practice.¹ The Postal Service requested that the information be treated as confidential by the Public Representatives. In order to obtain prompt access to the information, the Public Representatives agreed to treat the information as confidential. Consistent with that agreement, the Public Representatives are filing the information as a non-public annex. In doing so, the Public Representatives make no representation that the information being filed is entitled to confidential treatment.
