**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE UPDATED RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 264
CONCERNING TERMINATION DATE OF DIRECT ENTRY PARCELS NEGOTIATED
SERVICE AGREEMENT**

(March 5, 2010)

On July 31, 2009, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 264, adding the Direct Entry Parcels Contracts agreement at issue in this docket to the Competitive Products List.¹ In that Order, the Commission directed that the Postal Service give notice of the termination date of the specific agreement at issue and to update that information if it changed. The Postal Service provided August 9, 2009, as the start date for the agreement and August 8, 2010, as the termination date.²

In accordance with Commission Order No. 264, the Postal Service hereby provides an updated termination date for the Negotiated Service Agreement that is the subject of this docket. The termination date was effective on Saturday, February 13, 2010, at 11:59 p.m. Therefore, the Postal Service now asks the Commission to remove this agreement from the Competitive Products List.
